

Windows 10 IKE 3


The new IKE Tools and Desktop release provide the user with a work around for Windows 10. This involves inserting the SD card into the PC directly or via a 3rd party SD card-> USB adaptor. Instructions on this process are listed below.

Required IKE Tools and Desktop


1. IKE Tools version 6.5.4
2. IKE Desktop version 3.5.26

Opening a Form in IKE Desktop


1. Insert the SD Card into the card reader on the PC.
2. Open IKE Desktop.
3. In the upper left corner select **"File"**.
4. In the drop down menu select **"Open Form"**



5. On the left side the browsing window select **"SDHC (H:)"**
6. In the SDHC browsing window select **"Data"**




7. In the Data folder select the desired job to import.



8. Open the "Form Folder" open the "IKE" folder and select the "IWF File"




9. The selected form appears open in IKE Desktop.






Importing a Job into IKE Desktop

1. Insert the SD card into the PC.
2. In the Upper Left select "File".
3. In the drop down menu select "Import Job".



4. The folder browsing window appears, select "SDHC (H:)"



<p>5. Browse to the desired Job select and hit "OK"</p>		
<p>6. The importing Job message appears, select "OK"</p>		
<p>7. The Imports Ready message appears, select "OK"</p>		
<p>8. The imported job is now in IKE Desktop ready to view.</p>
